## PAINTING . . .

With Premium Tempera Paint, a smooth opaque paint that resembles "Gouache" or Watercolors. Transform Oil Pastels into a painting medium by using them with solvent.



## DRAWING . . .

With Pen & Ink, Graphite Pencils, Colored Pencils, learn a variety of techniques, such as shading and crosshatching. Try drawing with Oil Pastels on colored paper.



## SCULPTING . . .

Use Paper Mache, Wire, and/or Air-dried Clay to transform your idea into a freestanding, 3-dimensional, "IN THE ROUND" sculpture.



## PRINTMAKING . . .

Design, Carve and Print your own stamp to decorate cards and small boxes. Create "Monoprints", a painterly printmaking technique, whereby only one print is made.



## CRAFTING . . .

Use a wide variety of materials & techniques to create cards, ornaments, decorative boxes and stamps for scrapbooking. . . imagine the possibilities. Maybe even try "Metal Tooling".
